Two pricing tariffs are available. One is for single boxes up to 30kg in weight, and another for multiple parcel consignments and goods over 30kg in weight. Both tariffs combined provide excellent convenience and value, allowing even heavyweight goods to be transported.

Single Box Consignments

Prices are door to door and apply for consignments of just one box, weighing no more than 30kg in weight. The maximum length of any parcel is 1.5m, maximum length + girth combined cannot exceed 300cm. Transit times vary by destination and typically range from 2-5 working days.

Typical transit times are 2-5 working days to major cities. Outlying areas may take longer. Prices are door to door and apply for consignments up to 250kg total weight. Single pieces cannot weigh more than 70kg. Maximum length per piece is 2 metres, with a maximum length plus girth cannot exceed 330cm. The minimum weight per parcel is 8kg; any parcel weighing less than this will be charged at 8kg. Volumetric weight will be charged on all shipments. To calculate this, multiply the length, width and depth in centimetres by 6000. For example, a box with dimensions 50cm x 40cm x 40cm would be calculated as $50 \times 40 \times 40 = 80000$. Then, divide the answer by 6000, in this example $80000 / 6000 = 13.3$. The volumetric weight is 13.3kg, which will be the chargeable weight if the parcel weighs less than this. If the parcel weighs more than 13.3kg, the gross weight would be charged. All goods carried in accordance with our terms and conditions of carriage. Copies of which are available on request.
